 will complete Before the Interview Questions, the COMPASS Assessment, and OKCIS
 (Career Interest and Skills Inventory) to identify strengths and weaknesses and to
 help guide placement.
- 3. All applicants will be interviewed by a Gordon Cooper Technology Center counselor to determine appropriate placement. Some instructors will require a second interview.
- 4. Not everyone who applies for enrollment will be enrolled. You will be notified by phone or mail if you are accepted into a program.
- 5. You may apply for federal financial aid online at WWW.FAFSA.ED.GOV.

If applying for FAFSA, you must provide a copy of your high school diploma or GED.
